- How did it feel?

Engaging tweens and teens

- If you could solve one problem in the world, what would it be?
- What is something you're good at that you could share with others?
- Who is the most generous person you know? Why?

Transition from the kids table (Adults!)

- What are your earliest memories of giving?
- What is the most meaningful gift you have ever given?
- When was a time you led with your heart instead of your head?
